In Dyersville, like many communities around the Midwest, life is focused around agriculture. We take pride in our farm heritage and would like to salute today's farmers as well as the farmers of yesteryear.

Country Junction was designed and built in 1990 by Jerry and Jeanine Koch. Today, the restaurant is owned by Tom and Kay King and with their 75 employees they have created the Country Junction Family. Together we have made Country Junction the restaurant that it is today.

Country Junction is a view into the past with the antique tools, equipment, and memorabilia that make up our decor. True to life on the farm, we cook from scratch everyday because we believe that it makes a difference. You will notice that difference in our, home baked bread, real mashed potatoes, made from scratch soups, homemade hash browns and our famous pies with hand rolled crusts and meringue piled high.

Our building was built primarily of new materials with the exception of the giant beams that span the building, collected from a 100-year-old warehouse, and the original silo boards, barn board and beveled siding that were gathered from farm sites throughout the state. Visiting our antiques in our upstairs hayloft, you will find a triple box wagon from the Huff family farm in Wesley, Iowa. Our Gift Shop was added in 2000, and the boards used for the cupboard doors and red barn boards are from the 1930 King family farm in Fairbank, Iowa. Be sure to view the pictures between the restrooms to see how the Country Junction was built.

We serve breakfast, lunch, and dinner everyday. We also have several banquet and meeting rooms available to accommodate any small or large function.
